

Verification of Identity

Your FAFSA application was selected for identity verification by the FAFSA processing system. To satisfy this requirement, you are required to provide our office with a valid, unexpired government-issued photo identification (ID). This could include a driver's license, a U.S. passport, or other state-issued ID. We have outlined the potential ways that you can provide your identification to our office below.

- Appear in Person (Preferred Method) – You can provide a copy of your identification in person with our office on the Dowagiac Campus.
- Have a copy of your ID Notarized – Appear before a notary and have them provide a signed statement outlining that you appeared before them with your ID. You will need to provide the signed copy of your ID with the notary statement to our office.
- Complete a Video Call – This is only available to students who live over one hour away from the Dowagiac Campus. You will need to contact our office to set up the appointment and will need a working web camera to complete the call.
